We opened our outdoor sandpit this week which is always a sign of Summer Term beginning at Dropmore, we just need the weather to catch on! All year groups have been enjoying their new topic 'This is Britain'. This week Reception have read *The Queen's Hat* and looked at different London landmarks. On Friday, they learned about the national flowers of the countries in Great Britain and sketched the daffodils in our outdoor area.

This week, Year 1 have been learning to tell stories orally: *Dragon Dinosaur* and *This is the House that Jack Built*. They have also used adjectives to describe and used *and* to join clauses. In maths they have practised making arrays to show multiplication of 2s, 5s and 10s. Year 2 have been revising their addition facts from single digit addition to 2 digit addition. In English they have been learning about coordinating and subordinating conjunctions and how to write sentences using these. In PSHE the class have been learning about physical contact that we like and we don't like.

In topic this week KS1 built their own version of London in their classrooms, using various equipment to display famous landmarks. We were very impressed by their creations! Next week is a Coronation packed week! On Thursday we will be going across the road to the church and the woods as a whole school to carry out some Coronation themed work. Friday is mufti day, the children are invited to wear red, white and blue this day. We will be learning all about the Coronation and having a whole school coronation picnic outdoors. We hope you have a lovely long bank holiday weekend!
