PE lessons have started and we have been out on the field as much as we can before the cold weather sets in! Reception have read *The invisible string* and made some special hearts of the people they love. Towards the end of the week they had fun in our large outdoor school sandpit. On Thursday, I spent time in Reception running a 'pen disco', this involved the class drawing patterns or writing letters to music. The children tried very hard to hold their pens correctly and after we finished 'pen disco', we had our own real mini disco in the classroom!

Year 1 have settled into their new routines well. For maths, they have been recalling how to build the number 5 out of different numbers and count and sort objects carefully. In English the children have read 5 *Minutes Peace* and discussed how to use capital letters in their writing.

This week, Year 2 have used mathematical equipment to explore place value. The children partitioned 2-digit numbers into tens and ones. In RE, the class looked through our religious artefact boxes exploring and discussing what they could see. In Science, they thoroughly enjoyed making special fortune tellers linked to the seasons.

This Tuesday is our 'meet the teacher' session at 2pm. I have enclosed a letter along with the newsletter about it.

On Friday the PTA are holding a coffee morning/AGM in the hall.
