It has been a lovely week. The weather has been great and the children have worked hard. I have enjoyed visiting all three classes for my assembly this week. We remembered our 3 school values and talked about what 'independence' looks like for each year group. Most Reception children joined us full time this week. They started their new topic called 'All about me'. The children talked about their families and created family portraits, they also made their faces out of paper plates and various art and craft materials. Year 1 has had a wonderful week learning with the story Knuffle Bunny. They have been able to talk about the characters' feelings, predict an ending and recreate the story by changing one feature of the story. In maths they have been developing their vocabulary to compare numbers based on their value with the phrases "more/greater than", "less/fewer than" and "equal to". In topic they have been learning about the seven continents: ask them to sing you a song that helps us remember them. Year 2 have been learning how to write postcards and they made up some really interesting excuses for being late to school. They have been learning about the different continents and have learnt the names and locations of the 5 oceans. They have also been reminding themselves of some of the phonics sounds and practiced using them to read. The after school clubs started this week and have been well attended. It has been lovely to see the children take part in such a wide range of activities. Next week we hope to trial a Jacket Potato lunch for Year 1 and 2 on Tuesday. If it is manageable and successful then we will have a jacket potato lunch for Reception later in the week too. I hope you have a wonderful weekend!
