This week the theme in Reception has been 'Under the Sea'. At school they have been writing fact files about sea creatures and reading the story 'Rainbow Fish'. We have also covered odd and even numbers and have been so impressed by Reception's maths skills. Year 1 has been learning about the traditional tale Three Billy Goats Gruff, how to write questions and working in small teams to make bridges. In maths they have been revising place value by learning to count to and back from 100, and find 1 more or 1 less. Year 2 have been reading different alien poems and revised nouns, adjectives and rhyming. In maths they have been reviewing their knowledge of 2D and 3D shapes. In topic, Year 1 and 2 have been learning about Northern Ireland and the Legend of the Giant's Causeway. They have been asked to design a float as Northern Ireland hosts many parades and festivals.
