Welcome back to a new half term. I hope you had a lovely break. It is always nice to welcome the children back and we have already been working hard. Reception have been busy exploring their theme of 'Colour' this week. They have learnt about firework night and thoroughly enjoyed some messy firework splatter painting! As part of their PSHE work, they shared the lovely story 'The Colour Monster' and talked about different emotions. Following this the children produced some wonderful work, drawing and writing about how different scenarios make them feel. This week Year 1 has blown us away with their hard work in maths: they have learnt how to compare number sentences (i.e. 7+2 is more than 3+4). To do this they used balancing scales and number blocks to see how the number sentences compared. In English they have started to learn about the role of non-fiction books in learning and reading. Interestingly most of the children in Year 1 prefer to read non-fiction books during their independent learning time. In PSHE they are exploring what makes us the same, similar and different compared to our friends and how that makes a group of people special. Year 2 have had their first nativity rehearsal already.
