As part of National School Sport Week, the Reception children's theme for the week was 'Healthy Me'. They learnt about the different ways in which we can keep ourselves healthy and enjoyed various physical activities, their firm favourite being having a go at the hurdles! The children also looked at different foods and designed their own healthy lunchboxes. Year 1 have continued to learn through stories based on the Three Billy Goats Gruff, exploring adjectives and good sentence structure.
