In Year 1, the children have been revising how to write simple sentences using stories based in families to provide familiar content. This will be continued next week, when they will be bringing in a small, soft toy to share with the class and write a short story. In maths they have been revising numbers to 10 and have explored the vocabulary and associated symbols when comparing amounts. Miss Tolmie has been impressed by their efforts. Miss Tolmie has also been pleased with the number of children continuing their learning through their independent learning time, with children accessing reading, writing, maths and science activities regularly. Based on a story by John Burningham, Year 2 wrote postcards with wild excuses for why they were late for school. In Maths they started learning about place value for 2-digit numbers. In topic Year 1 and Year 2 have continued to explore media and associated tools, designing their own planets and contributing to a large school piece: Starry Night by Van Gogh. What a busy week!
