The children have also been learning the poem 'popcorn' the last few weeks and on Wednesday did an amazing performance of it in the school hall. We have recorded it and Miss Douglas will upload it to Tapestry this weekend for all the Reception parents to watch. Year 1 have been writing a dragon poem in the style of Moira Andrew's poem Portrait of a Dragon. In Maths they have been working on different methods for addition and subtraction within 20. Year 2 had a very busy week finishing their instructions to their own magical lands, creating their own ancient maps and writing instructions directing visitors around. They have also been learning the 2, 5 and 10 times table, and loved listening to the Percy Parker times table songs. In PSHE, every year 2 child has chosen a challenge, they are going to have to persevere and work hard to complete it over the next two weeks. In topic KS1 have been learning about chronology. They have looked at how castles have changed over time and used a timeline to order them. They have also learnt about many of the British Monarchs and enjoyed learning different facts about each one. They had to work especially hard to look at the dates to correctly put them onto a timeline.
