This week Reception started their new topic called 'All about me'. The children created some beautiful family portraits and very much enjoyed making their faces out of food! We look forward to seeing many of the parents on our 'Reception Meet The Teacher' call on Monday. This week Year 1 has greatly enjoyed using their toys and the story Knuffle Bunny to write their own brilliant stories where their beloved toy is lost and found. In maths they have revised counting up and back from 10, comparing their values and grouping objects by their properties. Year 2 have been comparing numbers and number sentences. They have been looking at different letters in preparation for writing their own letters next week. In science they have continued to name different materials and describe why they are used to make particular objects.
