Behaviour chart



Star — Reach for the stars! A sticker and two house points to recognise excellent behaviour



Sun — Start on the sun every morning. Children must aim to stay on the sun or reach for the star.

Warning triangle — Children are given a warning and moved to the warning triangle. They have time to reflect and improve their behaviour.



Sad Cloud – Depending on situation, this may involve time out for a few minutes, going to see Mrs Streete or the Class Teacher or speaking to parents.
