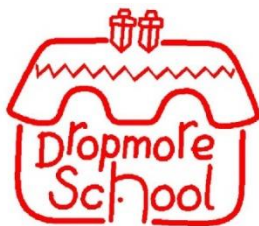

The children enjoyed a carousel of 4 activities, to decide which house would win the Sports Cup. On Thursday Year 1 & 2 treated us to their Dinosaur documentaries at our very own film premiere. Today we had our special House Assembly in which we also celebrated 100% attendance. You will find an attendance certificate in your child's bookbag. This week Reception have been learning all about the seasons and what perfect weather we have had to be learning about winter! In phonics, the class have been learning about capital letters and how they are written. On Friday the children had lots of fun reading 'The Runaway Chapatti', they talked about how the story was similar and different to 'The gingerbread man' and spent the morning making yummy chapattis with Mrs Emmett! Year 1 practised joining nouns and independent clauses using the word 'and', describing the perilous journey of Father Christmas in his quest to get a present to Harvey Slumpfenburger. They all took part in a friendly maths quiz to see how much they learnt. They wrapped up their RE topic on gifts by suggesting what they would give someone like Jesus if they were born today. Year 2 finished their Information texts. They spent time on the laptops typing them like real writers do and made labelled pictures to illustrate them. They are putting them together into their own big Dinosaur encyclopedia. KS1 had a fantastic afternoon tasting different dips and dippers to get ready to make their own for our Christmas party on Monday. They enjoyed trying new foods and finding out what countries they come from. KS1 completed their Discovering Dinosaurs topic by reflecting on what they have learnt and answering the question "What should we do with discoveries". They were able to suggest that we had the responsibility to share these discoveries and sustain them for others. They also had a fantastic time at their movie premiere and loved sharing their documentaries with their families.
