They have composed emails to send to Mrs Streete using all the evidence provided to reveal who ate the chocolate cake. Year 2 also had a fantastic time designing and creating junk model minibeasts. They used a variety of materials, different joins and paint to finish their final creations. They are incredible and would look fantastic on your mantelpiece 😊.
