## **Physical Education**

Physical Education is a very important part of the National Curriculum. To ensure that we meet safety directives I would ask you to comply with the following:-

- 1. <u>NO</u> jewellery should be worn in school at any time. This includes earrings which can be particularly dangerous in PE. If your child has pierced ears, please make sure that no earrings are worn on PE days.
- 2. Children who have long hair must keep their hair tied back. This is to prevent hair from hanging over the children's eyes or getting caught on any apparatus.
- 3. Please notify the school in writing if your child has to be excused from PE because of a temporary injury.

Please may I ask you to sign the form and return it to school as soon as possible.

Should my child incur any injury or accident from the wearing of earrings or jewellery during physical education, I understand that I take full responsibility and do not hold any member of staff from Dropmore Infant School responsible.

I am fully aware of the dangers of wearing jewellery whilst participating in physical activity and that it is against school policy to wear any jewellery at any time.
