

Reading



Early Learning Goal

Children read and understand simple sentences. They use phonic knowledge to decode regular words and read them aloud accurately. They also read some common irregular words. They demonstrate understanding when talking with others about what they have read.

Reading book – will be given out around October half term

Reading Record – to be filled in every time a child is read with at home or school. Please read with your child at least three times a week

Writing



Early Learning Goal

Children use their phonic knowledge to write words in ways which match their spoken sounds. They also write some irregular common words. They write simple sentences which can be read by themselves and others. Some words are spelt correctly and others are phonetically plausible.

We use cursive script

The children can log into Letterjoin at home to practice.

Maths



Early Learning Goal Children count reliably with numbers from one to 20, place them in order and say which number is one more or one less than a given number. Using quantities and objects, they add and subtract two single-digit numbers and count on or back to find the answer. They solve problems, including doubling, halving and sharing.

Early Learning Goal Children use everyday language to talk about size, weight, capacity, position, distance, time and money to compare quantities and objects and to solve problems. They recognise, create and describe patterns. They explore characteristics of everyday objects and shapes and use mathematical language to describe them.

We use White Rose Maths.

1. Writing

Laminated name card for writing. In addition, we will send home optional handwriting practice sheets. These will be sent out once we have started phonics.

Behaviour chart





Star — Reach for the stars! A sticker to recognise for excellent behaviour



Sun — Start on the sun every morning. Chdn must aim to stay on the sun or reach for the star.



Warning triangle — Chdn are given a warning and moved to the warning triangle. They have time to reflect and improve their behaviour.



Sad Cloud — Depending on situation, this may involve standing on spot/time out for a few minutes, going to see HT and/or CT speaking to parents.
