



The children had a lovely morning today with Mrs Jindal learning all about Diwali and taking part in dance workshops! A big thank you to Mrs Jindal for such a fantastic session, the children AND staff had a wonderful time!

This week the children in Reception have been detectives! After reading *The Gingerbread Man* they made Wanted posters to see if they could help the Police find him. In Maths they have been making the number 5 in different ways and they have been finding one more/ one less than a given number. In Phonics the children have been reading and writing longer words.

Year 1 have finished writing their non-fiction books about machines and will be publishing them for Year 2 to read next week. In maths they have covered 3D shape and have tested some of their properties. In RE the class enjoyed learning about Islamic art and creating their own tiles.

Year 2 have finished their animal diaries based on house animals. Miss Beeks was so impressed with them that the children will be making them into little booklets for the reading corner. In Maths the class have enjoyed solving missing number problems and mixed calculations. In Science Year 2 have covered different materials and how they are used.

Key Stage 1 also held a buddy reading session this week, with Year 2 hearing Year 1 read and helping them with their sounds. The Year 2 children very much enjoyed being the teacher and filling in their reading records!

The Nativity practices are in full swing, the stage is up and we have started dress rehearsals! Very exciting! The teachers have asked me to request you help your child practice any lines for Nativity. The children with lines also need to remember the name of the child who speaks before them. I sent out an email earlier today about the performances and how to book a time.


