## Supporting your child's transition into Dropmore

### Summer Term 2025

<b>April</b>	<b>Initial communication email sent out to new starters</b>
<b>June- July</b> <b><i>Nursery visits</i></b>	<b>Class Teachers will be making contact with School Nurseries.</b>  We will endeavour to visit your child in their pre-school setting. If this is not possible, we will organise a call with your child's key worker.
<b>June 27<sup>th</sup></b> <b><i>Stay and play at Dropmore!</i></b>	<b>Parents/carers and children are invited to a 'stay and play' on Friday 27<sup>th</sup> of June between 1:30-2:30.</b>  You will be able to join your child in the classroom to explore and play! It is also a nice opportunity to meet the teaching staff in your child's class and other parents and children. There will be some songs and a story for the children before you leave.
<b>July 2nd</b> <b><i>Induction afternoon</i></b>	<b>Induction afternoon 1:30-2:30</b>  On the induction afternoon, the children will be spending time in the classroom with their new teachers. Parents and carers will be invited to come to the hall for a talk from the Senior Leadership Team and discuss any questions they may have.
<b>July and September</b> <b><i>Home visits</i></b>	<b>Home visits</b>  We provide home visits now to all our families joining. We will start this in July, some may carry over into early September. During the home visits we will ask you questions about your child e.g. their interests, what they like to play with at home. It is also a chance for you to discuss any questions or concerns.
